Paul Twelftree is the Conservative City Council candidate for St Barnabas. He has lived in the area for eleven years, representing part of the ward previously as a City Councillor.

Paul has been leading the popular STAR (Save The Andover Road) campaign, to stop the Andover Road being closed and re-routed through the new Kings Barton estate. He firmly believes that this will cause traffic to back up and then drivers will use local residential roads as rat runs to avoid the inevitable traffic chaos. This has been a long standing campaign which he is optimistic will bring a positive result for local residents.

Previously, as a Councillor, as well as dealing with **local residents' problems**, Paul resisted inappropriate development along Harestock Road and successfully lobbied to keep the Harestock shops carpark free of parking charges.

He has recently spoken to the City Council and suggested solutions to the traffic and air quality problems in the city as well as lobbying the administration to bring forward building the park and ride at Kings Barton.

A former Captain in the Merchant Navy, when not working to improve the local area Paul works as a Harbour Pilot in Southampton, guiding some of the largest ships in the world safely in and out of the port.

PAUL'S PRIORITIES FOR ST BARNABAS

- Successfully keep the Andover Road open by continuing the STAR campaign.
- Develop a new entrance to Henry Beaufort School off the Andover Road and remove school buses and other school vehicles from Harestock and Weeke.
- Press for penalties for contractors and others who destroy the verges by parking on them.
- Reduce the speed of traffic through local estates by the use of appropriate traffic calming.
- Save the swimming pool and other facilities at Sir John Moore barracks for local use when it is re-developed.
- Work with the City and County Councils to reduce traffic and improve air quality in Winchester city centre.
- Push back against inappropriate planning applications that threaten the character of the area.
