WORKING FOR OUR COMMUNITY

Patrick Cunningham was elected chairman of Littleton & Harestock Parish Council in 2016 and continues to serve the local community in that role today. He has lived with his wife Joy and three children in Winchester since 1985, and in the Ward – in Littleton – for the past 18 years.

Patrick's career in the Hotel industry saw him running several multi-million-pound companies locally, in London, and also as UK Operations Director for an international hotel chain, giving him valuable and substantial financial experience at a high level.

Patrick has been very active in support of various local issues which concerned the Parish, and has spoken at the City Council's Planning Committee on many important planning matters. Working in conjunction with Sparsholt and Crawley Parish Councils in the protracted fight against Ecotricity's plans for an Anaerobic Digester, Patrick succeeded in having Littleton declared a No-Go Zone for all 18 ton tractor/trailer movements to and from Sparsholt College. Sparsholt Parish Council also achieved this result and further movement limitations were imposed.

In his role as Parish Council chairman, he has had many meetings with both County and City Council officers and councillors over a diverse range of residents' concerns including road safety and signage, speeding, footpath provision and pedestrian safety, hedgerow and grass cutting.

Flood Alleviation plans in North Winchester villages, and the Local Governance Review are currently major items on Patrick's agenda. He is pressing the County for a viable plan to reduce the impact of future flooding events, and encouraging resident involvement in the Local Governance Review.

Patrick says, "If elected, I will work closely with our two other Conservative Councillors in the Ward on improving the quality of life in our villages, focussing on the real issues which matter most. I am a keen supporter of the City Council's strategy of improving business, housing, the environment and health through a financially responsible and entrepreneurial approach for the benefit of all our residents.
